The Godhead - 3 in 1!!!

"And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory."

Isaiah 6:3

There are so many people in the world, even so-called Christians, who refute or reject the existence of a triune God. And yet the Bible offers irrefutable proof that there are 3 distinct persons in the Godhead with each having their own responsibilities to perform in regards to the creation and salvation of the human race, especially the writing of the Bible itself upon which our salvation is based.

There are many so-called Bible teachers, especially T.D. Jakes, who admitted he formerly preached the Jesus only doctrine, or "Oneness" theology, which rejects the doctrine of the Trinity, even though the Trinity is clearly revealed in the Old Testament. Isaiah 48:16 states "Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there am I: and now the Lord God (Father), and His Spirit (Holy Spirit), have sent me (Jesus). Also, Isaiah 61:1a states "the Spirit (Holy Spirit) of the Lord God (Father) is upon me (Jesus); because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek";

The fact that people refute the doctrine of the Trinity clearly shows that these men and women have not the Holy Spirit dwelling in them because "the Spirit of truth guides you into all truth" (John 16:13). The King James Bible, and only the King James Bible clearly states, "There are three who bear record in Heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost, and these three are one" (1 John 5:7). "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all" (Ephesians 4:4,5,6).

Over 1 billion Muslims in the world today deny that God doesn't even have a Son, let alone a Holy Spirit. That's over 1/7 of the world's entire population. Then when you add in almost a billion Hindus, and hundreds of millions more Buddhists, you begin to realize how idolatrous this world is. Add in the Shintoists, the New Agers, the Wiccans, the Satanists, the Agnostics, the Atheists, and all the other satanic man-made religions, and you realize how we are living in a Trinity rejecting world, the same Trinity that created the human race in their image (Genesis 1:26, 2:22) for their pleasure, fellowship, worship and love.

As you read through this Bible Study, it will be shown that the Trinity was present at both the Lord's birth and baptism, wrote the Bible through God-fearing men, participates in our salvation from beginning to end, and was even referenced at the Lord's death. May the Lord bless you with this study, and to those who are not saved, may the Lord open your eyes to the truth of the existence of the Holy Trinity, or the Godhead – 3 in 1.

- 1. First and foremost the Trinity was present at the birth and baptism of Jesus Christ.
 - The Birth: And the angel answered and said unto her, <u>The Holy Ghost</u> shall come upon thee, and the power of <u>the Highest</u> (Father) shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called <u>the Son of God.</u> (Luke 1:35).
 - The Baptism: And it came to pass in those days, that <u>Jesus</u> came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan. And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and <u>the Spirit</u> like a dove descending upon him: And there came a <u>voice from heaven</u> (the Father), saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. (Mark 1:9-11).
- 2. The Bible was also written:
 - By God (Father): All scripture is given by inspiration of God (the Father), and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: (2Timothy 3:16)

 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath

heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me. (John 6:45)

- For God (Jesus): And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/<a> to descriptures the things concerning https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/https://doi.org/https://doi.org/<a href="https:
 - Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. (John 5:39)

- Through God (Holy Spirit): Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. (2Peter 1:20-21)
- 3. And it doesn't stop there! All three members of the Godhead play an important part in the salvation of our souls.

The Trinity:

The Father Draws - No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:44)

Jesus Saves - For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost. (Luke 19:10)

The Holy Spirit Seals – In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were <u>sealed</u> with that holy Spirit of promise, (Ephesians 1:13)

Additional responsibilities of the Godhead, among many others:

The Father -

- 1. Prepared a body for God the Son Hebrews 10:5
- 2. Acknowledged Jesus as His beloved Son both at the Lords baptism and on the mount of Transfiguration Matthew 17:5
- 3. Gave Jesus works to do and to finish John 5:36
- 4. He, as the Father of lights, sends down all good gifts and perfect gifts James 1:17
- 5. Sent the comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, after Jesus left John 14:26
- 6. Judgeth no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son John 5:22
- 7. Raised up Jesus from the dead Acts 2:24
- 8. Gives Jesus the throne of his father David Luke 1:32

The Son -

- 1. Died on the cross and shed His holy blood for us Matthew 26:28
- 2. He is the propitiation (appeasing wrath) for the sins of the whole world 1 John 2:2
- 3. Jesus is our advocate with the Father 1 John 2:1
- 4. Is our mediator (go between) between God the Father and the human race 1 Timothy 2:5
- 5. Searches the reins (motives) of our heart Revelation 2:23
- 6. Frees us from the bondage of sin John 8:36
- 7. He is the author and finisher of our faith Hebrews 12:2
- 8. Gives to us eternal life 1 John 5:11-12

The Holy Spirit -

- 1. Testifies of Jesus John 15:26
- 2. Reveals the mystery of Christ Ephesians 3:4-5
- 3. Seals you in your heart 2 Corinthians 1:22
- 4. Quickens and gives life John 6:63
- 5. Guides you into all truth John 16:13
- 6. Speaks and directs your path Acts 10:19-20; Acts 13:2; Acts 16:6-7
- 7. Gives each Christian their individual spiritual gifts 1 Corinthians 12:8-11
- 8. Searches and reveals the deeper things of God 1 Corinthians 2:10-13
- 9. Shows you things to come (Prophecy) John 16:13
- 10. Restrains the evil and prevents the man of sin from coming 2 Thessalonians 2:7-8

4. And finally the Godhead, or the Trinity, was even referenced at the Lord's crucifixion:

As Jesus hung on the cross from the sixth hour to the ninth hour, there was darkness over all the land. And about the ninth hour, Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God (Father), my God (Holy Ghost), why hast thou forsaken me? (Matthew 27:45-46). This is what Jesus did for us all!

Jesus is coming soon! The day is rapidly approaching when the <u>Father</u> will give His command to the <u>Son</u> to go and remove all the <u>Spirit</u> filled Christians (the Church) from off the earth (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18). The time for repentance is NOW, before it is too late. As things become more and more chaotic and begin to spiral out of control not only in this country, but across the world, more and more people will be seeking answers as to what is going on all around them. The answer is simple – The Triune God. We are already in the time of sorrows (Matthew 24:8) and the Great Tribulation is right around the corner, "A time never seen before, or will ever be seen again" (v.21). "And except those days should be shortened, there shall no flesh be saved," Jesus said (v.22a).

After you have read this Bible study, you can know one thing for certain, it was not the devil, "the god of this world" (2 Corinthians 4:3,4) who led you to read this. Satan hates you and wants you in the lake of fire, where he and his angels are going for all eternity (Matthew 25:41). If you have not committed your life to Christ yet, and are seeking the truth, let the Father continue to draw you so Jesus can save you and the Holy Spirit can seal

you until the day of the Rapture.

God the Holy Father, God the Holy Son, and God the Holy Spirit are one God, the only true, living, uncreated God (Isaiah 44:6) who is ever-present, all-knowing, all-powerful and all-loving. He desires that every single person be forgiven, saved, and to live eternally with him (2Peter 3:9). He is our only real protection from what is coming upon the world, and His love for you is unchanging and everlasting. Accept Jesus Christ as your Saviour today, while there is still time (2 Corinthians 6:2). He is the one and only true Messiah who was willing to shed His sinless, spotless blood for the forgiveness of the world's sin (John 3:16). The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God (Father), and the communion of the Holy Ghost be with you all (2 Cor13:14)
