6. The Lord killed 24,000 with a plague when an Israelite brought a foreign woman into the camp in the sight of Moses (Numbers 25:6-9).
7. The Lord killed 70,000 with a pestilence when His Anger was kindled against Israel for their rebellion and sin (2 Samuel 24:1-15).
8. The Lord sent two she bears to kill 42 children because they were mocking Elisha the prophet of God (2 Kings 2:23-24).
9. The Lord Himself slew 185,000 Assyrian soldiers in one night when they invaded Judah and threatened Jerusalem (2 Kings 19:32-36).
